

# Rural County Government Leveraged LED Technology to Improve Lighting and Lower Energy Costs

#### **Situation**

Shasta County included a comprehensive lighting retrofit in an ENGIE ESCO project. ECM's lighting group was brought on for a turn-key installation at a variety of widely located sites which included the airport and the jail.

### **Project**

The project started the first day COVID-19 was first diagnosed in the US.\* After a couple weeks, the pandemic required a review of all workplace activities, and our team adopted new hygiene and social distancing workplace protocols.

This project was spread over a 50-square mile area. ECM installed almost 20,000 items: 79 types of lamps & fixtures, along with step-down transformers and Lutron controls.

The biggest challenge was retrofitting 5 Atrium chandeliers that required scaffolding which spanned a 14' space over 3 flights of stairs.
